## AVAILABLE STONE FINISHES

**Travertine** A variety of limestone (a sedimentary rock composed primarily of calcite and dolomite) which is a precipitant from hot springs.

**Crosscut** In opposition to "veincut" is when the travertine is cut parallel to its natural bedding plane presenting a mottled effect instead of the traditional horizontal lines.

**Honed Finish** A satin smooth finish with little or no gloss.

**Sawcut finish** A rough surface finish resulting from the sawing process.

**Filled** The natural holes of the travertine are filled at the factory with a mixture of travertine powder and acrylic resin.

**Unfilled** The natural holes of the travertines are left unfilled.
